Children - Reception - CW + OR

<u>Question</u>	<u>Response</u>
<u>Do you enjoy your Reading lessons?</u>	- reading the new words - really love reading books.
<u>What are do you think you are good at?</u>	- new words
<u>What do you think you need to work on?</u>	- keeping healthy + trying hard.
<u>What helps you learn in Reading?</u>	- we ask questions
<u>What do you do when you get stuck?</u>	- sound - it - out - ask the teachers
<u>Do you practice your Reading at home?</u>	- Lots of home reading - different sessions evident.
<u>Do you think Reading is useful in the real world?</u>	- Yes, you can teach people to read.
<u>Is there anything you would like to do differently in Reading?</u>	- Go in the reading corner more.

CW + OR - CW - confident/challenged appropriately.

Children - Year 1/2 - CSL + MO

<u>Question</u>	<u>Response</u>
<u>Do you enjoy your Reading lessons?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Yes, I like doing the questions</li> <li>- Yes, I like the new stories.</li> </ul>
<u>What are do you think you are good at?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- new words</li> <li>- expression (voices)</li> </ul>
<u>What do you think you need to work on?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- learning bigger words</li> <li>- using reasons.</li> </ul>
<u>What helps you learn in Reading?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- using the story for the information</li> <li>- sentence starters</li> </ul>
<u>What do you do when you get stuck?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- tell a friend (partner-talk)</li> <li>- use the book</li> </ul>
<u>Do you practice your Reading at home?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- lots of home reading</li> <li>- 1-2x weekly - school staff</li> </ul>
<u>Do you think Reading is useful in the real world?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- it can help with writing</li> <li>- it helps you to read other things</li> <li>- smart = good jobs.</li> </ul>
<u>Is there anything you would like to do differently in Reading?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- read in the person's voice.</li> </ul>

CSL + MO - Both can read confidently + are challenged appropriately.



## Pupil Interview - Reading

Children - Year 3/4 - MH + IBA

<u>Question</u>	<u>Response</u>
<u>Do you enjoy your Reading lessons?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- reading new books/stories</li> <li>- learning new vocabulary</li> </ul>
<u>What are do you think you are good at?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- answering VIPERS questions</li> <li>- trying out new vocabulary</li> </ul>
<u>What do you think you need to work on?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- expression when reading voices.</li> </ul>
<u>What helps you learn in Reading?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- we break the words down</li> <li>- we use the new learning in our other lessons.</li> </ul>
<u>What do you do when you get stuck?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- use the text</li> <li>- have a good go/what is most likely to happen?</li> </ul>
<u>Do you practice your Reading at home?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Reading diaries show lots of home reading + checked weekly by school staff.</li> </ul>
<u>Do you think Reading is useful in the real world?</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Yes, the stages help us to get better.</li> <li>- It will help us for jobs.</li> </ul>
<u>Is there anything you would like to do differently in Reading?</u>	<p>No, we like our VIPERS sessions.</p>

MH + IBA - Both read aloud with great fluency + books challenge both readers well and are accessible.
