The Intent, Implementation and Impact of our Curriculum

Intent

Physical Education is high-quality curriculum which inspires all pupils to succeed and excel in competitive sport and other physically-demanding activities. At Tittensor we provide opportunities for pupils to become physically confident in a way which supports their health and fitness. Children are provided with opportunities to compete in sports and other activities to build character and help to embed values such as fairness and respect.

We believe that a healthy body supports that of a healthy mind and we endeavour to ensure that the well-being and the development of a healthy lifestyle and the centre of our PE curriculum.

Implementation

At Tittensor, we expect that all teachers fully engage with the PE curriculum. At Tittensor First School we allocate 2 hours of physical education and additional structured outdoor play each week, as we believe that this provides the minimum entitlement for each pupil to achieve a broad and balanced Curriculum. This is supplemented by a programme of out of hours learning opportunities.

We strongly believe in the inclusion of all pupils and all pupils are expected to participate in physical education lessons. Staff promote the inclusion of all pupils through planning and delivering lessons which have been developed in accordance to children's specific learning and/or physical needs.

Impact

Our PE curriculum, which is continually being reviewed and improved, is high quality, well thought out and is planned to demonstrate progression in the children's skills and knowledge. In addition, we measure the impact of our curriculum through the following methods:

- Assessments of standards achieved against the planned outcomes. All data and assessment is recorded and stored on DCP Pro for monitoring and evidence purposes.
- A celebration of learning for each term
- Pupil discussions about their learning.

The impact of our curriculum will also be measured by how effectively it helps our pupils develop into well rounded individuals who embody our values and carry with them the knowledge, skills, and attitudes which will make them lifelong learners and valuable future citizens. We endeavour to have our school's core values embedded and utilised. These are: *Love, Faith, Hope*. When children leave Tittensor, they are ready for their journey to Middle school with good attitudes towards learning.
