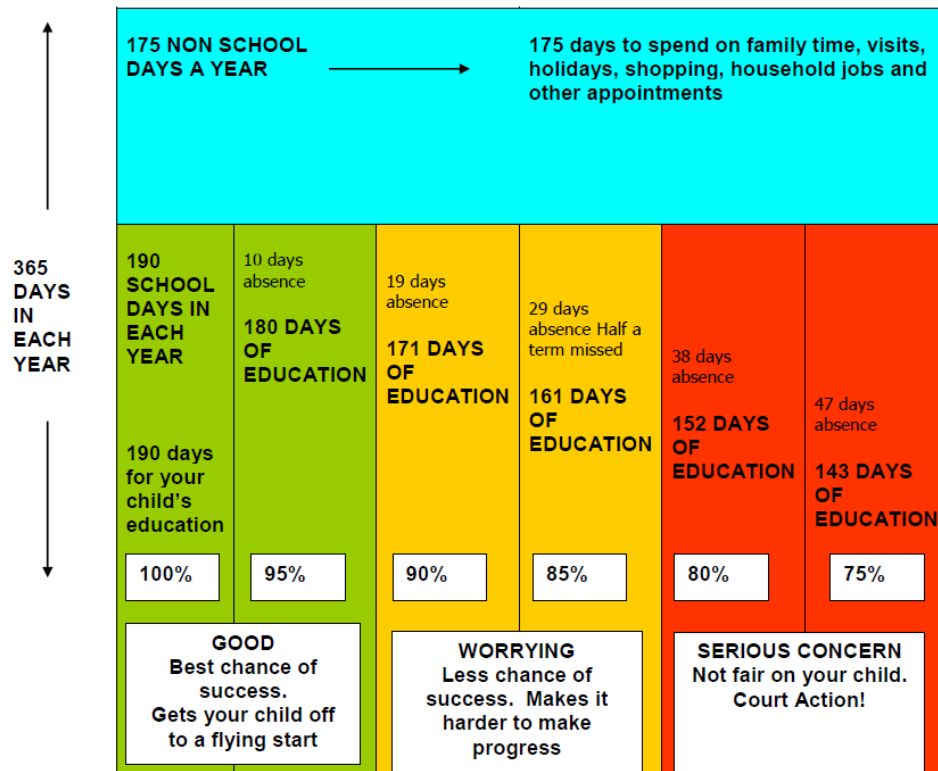

School Day

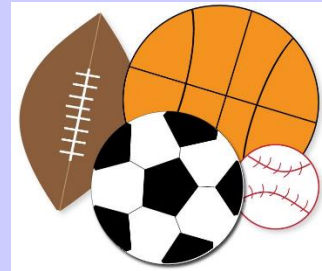


Doors open: 8.40am
